FUNDRAISING GROUP UPDATE

A crowd of 17 people attended a lively meeting full of great ideas for how we can raise funds and how we can engage our wider community in helping us achieve the £9k target required for the Home Office application. However, as we are all well aware this is a premium priced area for the rental market and therefore we are mindful that we will probably need to exceed this £9k target.

We know that many parishioners wish to make a regular contribution throughout the two-year programme, others want to make a one-off contribution, others want to take part in fun events. We are therefore going to make room for all of these activities.

Regular contribution by standing order: We will be outside Church on the weekends of 3rd/4th March and 17th/18th March handing out standing order forms. If you are able to make a monthly contribution and are a UK tax payer we will also be able to reclaim gift aid through this method from the Treasury. Please do sign up to a monthly amount if you can as this will really help with the evidence we require for the application process – it can be any amount you can afford from say £2 to whatever.
